

# ARTICLE III OFFICERS

## Section 1. DESIGNATION

The officers of the Association shall be individual members in good standing and constitute: President, President-Elect, President Elect-Elect, Immediate Past-President, Chairpersons of each Standing committee, Presidents of each division, and the Executive Director, [Executive Assistant](#) and Treasurer who without voting rights shall constitute the Executive Board.

1. All officers of the Association, except the Executive Director, [Executive Assistant](#) and Treasurer who are appointed by the Board, shall be elected or ratified by the Association membership to serve one year terms or until successors are selected.

## Section 2. TERMS AND DUTIES OF OFFICERS

4. The President Elect-Elect shall become President-Elect of the Association in the July Crossover meeting following the term of the previous President-Elect. ~~The President Elect-Elect shall be chair of the Leadership Development committee.~~

# ARTICLE IV STANDING COMMITTEES
